On the Cover | Bernaerdt van Orley's *Altarpiece of Saints Thomas and Matthias* The cover is the third of four wooden panels the Dutch painter created for the Notre Dâme de Sablon in Brussels, Belgium. The second and third panels were bought for the Vienna Art History Museum in 1809 by Emperor Francis I; the first and fourth panels are preserved in the Royal Fine Arts Museum of Belgium. The image depicts the moment when, after Christ's ascension, Matthias was appointed to replace Judas as an Apostle by the casting of lots. This event is depicted in a setting of significant fantasy architecture in the Renaissance style, giving it an aethereal and almost perfect feel, though that sentiment is rudely interrupted by the foreshadowing in the background. In the background, images of scenes where various saints were being martyred are depicted, indicating how several people in the foreground would eventually finish their service to Christ. van Orley was commissioned to make the piece by the Guild of Masons and Carpenters, of whom the patron saints are Saints Thomas and Matthias.


